Message: "How Good Is Good Enough?"

Scriptures: Romans 3:10, 21-25; James 2:10

1. Ice Breaker: Share your favorite Easter memories!
2. Read Romans 3:10. What does this passage say about God's standard of "goodness"?
3. Talk about the "chasm" between man's perspective and God's perspective of "being good enough" to go to heaven.
4. In your life, have you ever struggled with the thought that "I have to be good enough for God to let me into heaven"?
5. Read Romans 3:19-20. What is the purpose of God's Law?
6. Read Romans 3:21-25. If Hope is alive because Jesus is alive, how would you convince someone from this passage that there's hope for sinners to go to heaven?

CHALLENGE: 1) Repent 2) Be baptized 3) Share the good news that "forgiven people go to heaven." Let's remove the confusion and let God set the standard of goodness.
