Series: THE REAL THING: Living for Impact

Message: “Real LIFE”

Scriptures: Romans 6:3-13; Galatians 5:17

1. Ice Breaker: Share a God-moment you’ve had this week.
2. Do a quick search New Testament search on the word “life” and see how many times it appears. Notice which gospel writer surpasses them all! Notice, Romans comes in a distant second.
3. Read Romans 6:3-4. What stands out to you in this passage?
4. Reflect on MercyMe’s song, “Say I Won’t” when they sing: “I’m gonna know what it means to live and not just be alive.”
5. Read Romans 6:5-7. In what ways are we united with Christ?
6. Let’s be REAL: Galatians 5:17 tells us that the flesh and the Holy Spirit are in conflict with one another. How do you decide in your own life who wins the fight?
7. Read Romans 6:11-13. Reflect on your body as an “instrument of righteousness” rather than an “instrument of wickedness.”

Bottom Line: Real Life means being united with Christ because Jesus is the source of Real Life!

- Being united with Christ means: 1) we experience baptism; 2) we die to sin; and 3) we live for Jesus.

Challenge: It’s time to die to the things that are holding you back from trusting and following Jesus. It’s time to be united with Christ and experience Real Life!
