Series: THE REAL THING: Living for Impact

Message: "I'm Available"

Scriptures: Matthew 28:18-20

- 1. <u>Ice Breaker</u>: Share a God-moment you've had this week. (Group leaders: I know this is a repeat ice-breaker, but it's one that you should always have in your back pocket when leading a group.)
- 2. Read Matthew 28:16-20. Notice that the word "therefore" refers back to the "all authority" statement of Jesus. Why is this significant?
- 3. Some people are banking on living their lives as if there is no God, only then to give a "death-bed confession" so that they can get into heaven. What would you say to someone who held to this philosophy of living in light of Matthew 28:18-20?
- 4. What does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus?
- 5. What does it mean to be a disciple-maker?
- 6. Read Matthew 28:19-20. What do disciple-makers do in light of this verse?
- 7. How could your church improve making disciples?

Bottom Line: Understanding your purpose begins with this biblical principle: Be available to God.

- Be available by 1) **surrendering** to the authority of Jesus Christ, and 2) **partnering** with God's mission. Remember, it's His mission.
- Don't forget that no matter how overwhelming the mission can be, Jesus said, "I AM WITH YOU!" (Matthew 28:20, my emphasis).

<u>Prayer Challenge</u>: Ask God, "Align my dreams and desires with Yours, so that I can live on purpose for You."
