Series: THE REAL THING: Living for Impact

Message: “Living Out Your Purpose”

Scriptures: Ephesians 2:10; 4:1-16

1. Ice Breaker: Practice saying the Vision statement by memory. Now try to say the Mission statement from memory. How did you do?
2. Before you got serious about trusting and following Jesus, what was important to you? What would you say your purpose was in life, before Jesus became Lord of your life?
3. Read Ephesians 2:10. Reflect on the words “handiwork” / “good works” / “prepared in advance.”
4. Read Ephesians 4:1-3. Talk about what it means to “live a life worthy of the calling you have received.”
5. Talk about the differences between “Shared Purposes” and “Unique Purposes.”
6. Read Ephesians 4:4-16. What speaks to you in this passage?
7. How do you “fit” into the “puzzle” at Connect (or the church you attend)?

Bottom Line: God has created you and shaped you to live out your purposes in Christ Jesus!
