Scriptures: 2 Timothy 3:14-17

- 2. Read 2 Timothy 3:2-5. Your choices reveal what you value. How is God calling us to live differently than the description from this passage?

- 4. Read 2 Timothy 3:14-17. What does the Bible say about itself? (Hint: at least three things in this passage)
- 5. How do you personally demonstrate the value of biblical authority?
- 6. How can you help the "this generation" and the "next generation" value biblical authority over opinions/friends/media/therapist/professors/culture?
