Series: THE REAL THING: Living for Impact

Message: “We Value Biblical Authority”

Scriptures: 2 Timothy 3:14-17

1. Ice Breaker: How much do you know about our new worship pastor, Derek Fields (wife is Hiatt)? If possible, find a way to welcome him to Connect.
2. Read 2 Timothy 3:2-5. Your choices reveal what you value. How is God calling us to live differently than the description from this passage?
3. If you trust and follow Jesus, your convictions should be rooted in God’s Word. How should we communicate those convictions? (Hint: Read 2 Timothy 2:24)
4. Read 2 Timothy 3:14-17. What does the Bible say about itself? (Hint: at least three things in this passage)
5. How do you personally demonstrate the value of biblical authority?
6. How can you help the “this generation” and the “next generation” value biblical authority over opinions/friends/media/therapist/professors/culture?

Bottom Line: God is the source of all Truth and has revealed His thoughts in the written Word of God – the Bible. The Bible is the inspired, inerrant Word of God, and it can be trusted.
