Discussion Questions

Series: SURROUNDED Message: "Surrounded by Intercessors" Scriptures: Acts 12:5ff; 2 Corinthians 4:17-18; Ephesians 6:18

- 1. <u>Ice Breaker</u>: Think about a moment in the last three weeks when you received good news. Share with the group what the news was and how it made your feel.
- 2. Intercessory prayer is simply praying for others. Read Acts 12:5 and describe how the church prayed for Peter. Discuss the manner in which they prayed.
- 3. God expects Christians to intercede for others. How would you teach a new believer to do this? (It may be helpful to read Ephesians 6:18.)
- 4. God's understanding is beyond our understanding (Isaiah 55:8-9; 1 Corinthians 1:25). How does this affect your understanding of how God answers prayer?
- 5. God honors earnest prayers. ("Earnest" means with sincere and intense conviction.) Acts 12:5 says the church was earnestly praying to God for Peter. What does that look and sound like in your prayer life?
- 6. God deserves the glory for answered prayer. Read Acts 12:17. Who does Peter give the glory to, and who does he not give the glory to?
- 7. Take time as a group to intercede for others. It is one of our shared purposes to pray for one another. It's a powerful way to show Real Love to people.

Bottom Line: Surround others with your earnest prayers. It's one way we can show Real Love to people.

What is your next step?

- Begin interceding for people in your inner circle.
- Spend more time in prayer being the "Go-Between" for people.
- Persist in prayer; don't just pray about it once. (Luke 18:1-8)
- Keep a journal of prayers you pray for others.
- Put Real Love into action by praying for strangers, friends, family, neighbors, co-workers, enemies, etc.
