**Series: NOT TODAY, SATAN**

**Message: “God is Pro-Sex”**

**Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 7:1-5**

1. Ice Breaker: Answer the question: would you wear a t-shirt that says, “God is Pro-Sex -1 Cor. 7:1-5”? Why or why not?
2. Among other things, it’s so important to understand the historical and cultural context of a specific passage, as well as understanding who is the audience and the author of the First Letter to the Corinthians. Read and explain 1 Cor. 7:1 in context.
3. Read 1 Cor. 7:2 – what is the meaning and application of this Scripture?
4. Read 1 Cor. 7:3-5 – what does this passage say about God? what does this passage say about people?
5. In your opinion, when and where is it appropriate for church leaders to talk to kids/students/adults (in group settings) about God being Pro-Sex?
6. How can the family of God (the Church) show REAL HOPE in helping people with their marriages (think beyond what we already do; think BIG!)? Share your ideas with staff or elders so that these ideas can be prayed, discerned, and considered. Thanks!

**Bottom Line: You matter to God, whether you are married or single. If you are married, protect your marriage. Allow Christ to heal any hurts.**
