Message: “The Single Life”

Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 7:7-9, 28-29, 31,32-35

1. Ice Breaker: Since we all start out single, talk about some of the highlights of your single life.
2. Read 1 Corinthians 7:7-9. What do you learn about the single life?
3. Read 1 Corinthians 7:28-29, 31. What do you learn about married life?
4. Read 1 Corinthians 7:32-35. What are the advantages and disadvantages of the single life and married life according to this passage?
5. What is more important to God than your marital status?
6. Marrieds and Singles need one another because they are the body of Christ. How can the Church do a better job of connecting these groups of people together? (Please read 1 Corinthians 12:12, 14)

Bottom Line: Your identity is not in your singleness or your married status; your identity is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
